Jurien Bay

Our journey begins in Jurien Bay, where we will meet for dinner on Friday night. From there we'll make a short journey on Saturday morning to embark on our private freedive charter voyage, exploring the sea lion colonies, coral reefs and marine life of the Jurien Bay Marine Park. An incredibly biodiverse coral reef ecosystem flourishes off the Coral Coast with opportunities to freedive with wild Australian Sea Lions, bottlenose dolphins and various reef fish species.

For 3 days and 2 nights we will enjoy freediving, community and nature with plenty of time for connection while visiting the Lesueur National Park during wildflower season and while staying in seaside cabins conveniently located in Jurien Bay. Weather permitting, we'll embark on daily ocean freedives and explore wilderness areas in the region, allowing room to relax, breathe and recover from the stresses of every day modern life.

Jurien Bay Marine Park

The Jurien Bay Marine Park is located 240km north of Perth, and is known for its beauty and abundance of marine life. The park extends south from Green Head to the southern boundary of Nambung National Park (Wedge Island) and encompasses many of the islands located in this region.

With excellent freediving, snorkeling and swimming, Jurien Bay Marine Park is a beloved West-Australian travel destination to all those who love water-based fun.

Home to large colonies of rare Australian Sea Lions, Jurien Bay Marine Park also boasts large colonies of seabirds, a large population of western rock lobsters and a huge variety of fish.

On boat trips to watch the sea lions, you may see whales migrating along the coast or dolphins frolicking offshore.



Lesueur National Park

Lesueur National Park is a botanic oasis, just 20km northeast of Jurien Bay that will delight all nature lovers. On Saturday afternoon we'll journey north to see its fascinating natural attractions and discover salt lakes, coastal dunes, Mount Lesueur and Mount Michaud with the option to hike to the top of Mount Lesueur (4km) to take in its gorgeous panoramic ocean views.

In spring the park transforms into a wildflower wonderland with its vibrant colours and superb diversity of plants, views, and wildlife that will have you reaching for your camera.

We'll explore this important conservation area that is home to 122 species of native bird and 52 reptile species that rely on the park's diverse vegetation for survival.

Entry is from Cockleshell Gully Road which, although unsealed, generally has a good surface and is usually suitable for two-wheel drive vehicles. Care must be taken after the rain. Entry is \$17 per vehicle or included if you already have an annual National Parks Pass.

Full fees or minimum deposit to be paid (\$500) to secure place by 2 October. All fees are fully refundable before 18 September. To qualify for the EARLY BIRD price, full fees must be paid before 5pm on 18 September (\$750 - \$1,150 AUD).

Travel to Jurien Bay is your responsibility. You may indicate to me that you are keen to car-pool, save trees, reduce your carbon footprint at least 1 week prior to our trip so I may create a freedive group Whatsapp chat to facilitate car pooling in a safe, social setting.

Please ensure you book early to avoid disappointment. Limited places (14 freedivers, 6 non-freedivers maximum).

Strictly no cancellations or refunds beyond 18 September. Final fees due by 18 September for Early Bird Price and 9 October for Regular Price*.

*Late payment of fees beyond 9 October will incur a late fee of \$50 per day late.
